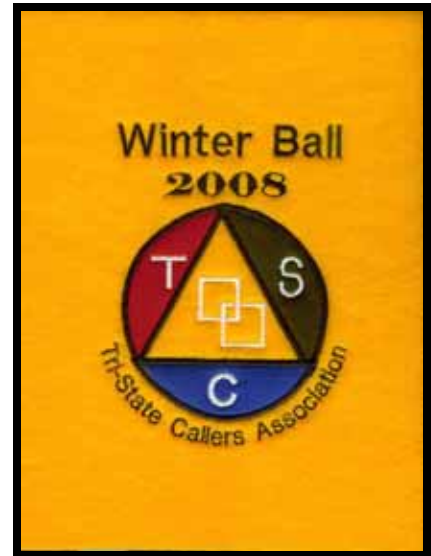

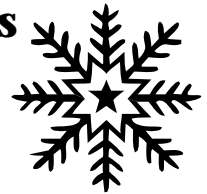

This Sunday afternoon event will give new dancers an opportunity to dance to the calling of many Tri-State Callers, some of whom are legends in the activity. This is a great opportunity to experience various styles of calling, many pleasing voices, and different dance tempos.

Another high point will be the exchange of ideas and the making of new dance friends from around the New England area. It will be an afternoon of exciting fun!

The Square Dance Foundation of New England's Baldwin Library/Museum will be open before, during, and after this Tri-State Callers' Winter Ball. It will be hosted by SDFNE officers and members of the Board of Directors who will give you an informative tour. They will answer any questions you may have regarding the SDFNE. Visit and see **Square & Round Dance History Come Alive!** You'll end up wanting a membership in the Foundation.

This dance is designed especially for the new dancers who started learning how to square dance in the Fall of 2007. If you are an experienced square dancer, please consider coming to this dance in support of our newest dancers. Let's make sure they feel comfortable as they venture out to what may be their very first dance.

The callers for this dance will be advised to limit their calling to the CALLERLAB Basic Program – which is the first 52 calls on the current Basic/Mainstream list. Club officers who are overseeing a class – please make sure your club caller is aware of this.

A specially made Tri-State courtesy banner will be presented to each club with dancers in attendance. Each club planning to attend must notify Tri-State in advance that a banner will be needed for presentation to their club. A banner will then be embroidered for each club that notifies us that they will have dancers attending. Again this year, Purple Heart certificates and Purple Heart dangles will be awarded to dancers who dance a tip with 3 callers in their square. Put the date on your calendar and don't miss this great opportunity, whether you are a new dancer or a veteran dancer.

If you collect caller signatures, this is a great way to get a few more in your book.
